

Macro Workshop for Advance Learners

Being a passionate insect photographer having more than 6000 hrs of field experience, this workshop module has been designed basically for those enthusiastic and hobbyist insect photographers. This workshop will cover both basic and advance learning part.

Workshop will be for two day (preferably Saturday and Sunday)

Following topics will be covered under this program:

Day: One

Theoretical Part (Duration: 90 minutes)

- Macro photography using DSLR/Mirrorless Camera – an overview.
- Why macro lens and what it specifies.
- How it differs from other lenses.
- Importance of depth of field in macro photography and its application.
- The effect of focal length and its contribution in macro composition.
- Importance of shutter speed in macro photography and its application
- Use of proper ISO value for macro photography
- How to gain magnification for macro photography
- Ethical issues in macro photography for field work
- Art of unique macro composition
- Showing macro photography with detail discussion on technical aspects
- Question & Answer session

Refreshment (Duration: 30 minutes)

Practical Session (Duration: 90 minutes)

- Familiarized with effective use of environment suitable for his field work along with technical details.
- Techniques of making steady hands for sharp focusing at higher magnification.
- Selection of right posture at different height of subject
- Selection of angle for macro photography to make it unique
- Focusing technique for different subjects in different situations.
- Analysis of each participant's photo shoot and necessary recommendation for their growth and prosperity.



Day: Two

Theoretical Part (Duration: 90 minutes)

- Concept of focusing technique.
- Concept of different framing style.
- Concept of previsualisation of a frame
- How previsualisation of frame benefits workflow and uniqueness.
- Use of natural light and speedlight at different situations.
- Selection of right magnification for framing.
- How dynamic range contribute to photography...way to maximize.
- Post processing techniques and its workflow.
- Concept of modern gear and their utility.

Refreshment (Duration: 30 minutes)

Practical Session (Duration: 90 minutes)

Technology of photography has been changing at a rapid speed. Unless we adopt these changes, we can't sustain. The session will be highly with modern gear. However, DSLR technology is still popular. Hence, it will cover both.

This session will fine tune all of your thought process, execution in the field covering all that were explained in the theoretical section.

Sharing of knowledge will be the top priority. Restricting to particular topics may limit the scope of learning. Hence it will be highly interactive, practical hands on experience.

Finally, a closing discussion for clearing all doubts and some examples why macro photography is so crucial than other field of photography and scope of recognition.

Please Note:

The program outline is only indicative and the sequence of topics covered mentioned above may change depending upon the situation. Priority will be given on knowledge sharing and one workshop may vary with another workshop depending upon the participant's knowledge and various other factors.

Both Theoretical and Practical session will be especially in any sanctuary or in a garden where there will be ample scope of close discussion and in field shooting guidance.
